## Menu of Free Workshops

**Transition Planning with Sticky Notes**– Developing a Transition IEP does not have to be a difficult process and can be mastered in just six easy steps. This workshop, will show an alternative way to look at transition planning and get the creative juices flowing. It will show you that with that with a little creativity and an open mind, all you really need to develop and implement an effective Transition IEP is a sharpie and a package of sticky notes.

**Self-Directed IEP** – When a child with a disability begins to move toward adult life, it is important to consider their needs and preferences in transition planning. This workshop provides an overview of the student’s role in the transition process, IEP meetings, and in discussing their needs and preferences.

**From IEP to IPE** – This workshop focuses on the process of transition planning for middle school aged students and older. After public school, Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) may be a critical resource for gaining, maintaining, or regaining employment. The services through VR must be detailed in the development of the IPE (Individualized Plan for Employment.) This workshop connects the various systems together to help improve outcomes for students with disabilities.

**Standing up For Me Training** is a Florida curriculum designed to teach key self determination concepts to students with disabilities This exciting curriculum encourages students to increase their involvement in the planning of their education and lives, develop self advocacy skills necessary to be successful, develop an understanding of their strengths and needs, establish goals, and develop a plan for accomplishing goals.

**Transition from School to Community** – All of a child’s education in school is in preparation for the day when the student leaves school and transitions into the adult world. This workshop provides an explanation of the Transition Planning process which begins at age 14 and includes an overview of Florida’s Diploma options and strategies for developing transition goals.

**Collaborative Communication and the Individual Plan for Employment** - This workshop helps participants to have a better understanding of how to build collaborative relationships when developing an Individual Plan for Employment (IPE) and Post School Outcomes.

**In the Driver’s Seat** is a series of six workshops for youth in transition from high school to adult life. During the workshops, youth experience hands-on learning that enables them to achieve adult life goals. With encouragement and support, young adults identify their skills, interests, and needs and work toward improving their ability for self-advocacy.
